HOPE HARBOUR MARINA

This is a cruise of many parts. Compare the magnificence of the Sovereign Islands with the natural undisturbed beauty of the north arm of the Coomera River. See the real Sanctuary Cove with its marine village and numerous private harbours.

Departing from the Ramada Hotel at Hope Harbour this 2 hour smooth water cruise

heads along the south arm of the Coomera River past Paradise Point and on to the Sovereign Islands. This group of largely man made, interconnected islands dominated by a huge array of spectacular dwellings is home to many of the rich and famous.

Rounding the southern end of the islands we enter the Broadwater at a point where we can appreciate just why the early pioneers called it that. A beautiful big expanse of water flanked by South Stradbroke Island stretching out to the north and south, with a clear view of the Gold Coast high rises and the border ranges.

We head north along the west coast of South Straddie to the mouth of the north arm of the Coomera River to wind our way back along this natural waterway to Sanctuary Cove. We complete the circuit via the private harbours that line the river back to Hope Harbour.
